Dale Kennington

Dale Kennington was born in Savannah, Georgia, and has spent most of her life in Dothan, Alabama. Mrs. Kennington holds a B.A. in Art History and Design from the University of Alabama. In her more than thirty years as an artist, she has been featured in fifteen one-man shows and thirty-one group museum shows. Her work is included in the permanent collections of the Montgomery Museum of Fine Arts; Jule Collins Smith Museum of Fine Arts in Auburn; the Huntsville Museum of Art; the Wiregrass Museum of Art in Dothan; the Columbus Museum in Columbus, Georgia; Cheekwood Museum of Art in Nashville, Tennessee; the collection of King Carl Gustav XVI of Sweden; the Federal Reserve; American Committee for UNICEF in New York; and the United States Embassy in Paris, among others throughout the United States. In 2009, Mrs. Kennington was recognized by the Alabama State Council on the Arts and the Alabama Bureau of Tourism and Travel as one of Alabama's "Master Artists."

Artist Statement

I have always been fascinated by the infinite variety of the usual, the undistinguished. There are only so many world wars, mass murderers, Nobel prize winners, but there are never ending varieties of familiar ordinary. Merging together, these give us a virtual census of place, of a people, of our society as a whole. I paint the things we have in common, the familiar rituals we repeat time and again without thought. "Out of the ordinary," by definition, tells us what we are not. The commonplace tells us what we are.

MAG 2011 CALL for ENTRIES

45th Annual Montgomery Art Guild Regions Bank Exhibition

ELIGIBILITY

All artists 18 years old or older are eligible to enter the exhibition. Artists may submit up to 4 works (in any category) into the exhibition that has not shown in a MAG exhibition and only work that has been completed within the past two years (2009–2011).

FEES

Regular entry fee for one work is \$50, the fee for two works is \$60. The third and fourth entrees are \$5 each. Regular entry fees are nonrefundable and include the \$40 Montgomery Art Guild 2011–2012 regular membership. Student (ages 18–21) entry fee for one work is \$36, the fee for two works is \$42. The third and fourth entrees are \$5 each. Student Entry fees are nonrefundable and include the \$30 Montgomery Art Guild 2011–2012 student membership. Students must present a current school I.D.

LIABILITY

Every precaution will be exercised in the handling of the entries. However, the Montgomery Art Guild and Regions Bank will not be responsible for any damage or loss.

Works must be claimed during pick up times only and not before. See calendar for pick up dates and time.

Proper I.D. is required of anyone picking up artwork.

Works claimed by someone other than the artist require a note with:

- Title of the work
- Name of the person picking up
- Signature of the artist

Any unclaimed art after 6 p.m., Friday, September 23, 2011, becomes the property of the Montgomery Art Guild to dispose of as it sees fit.

SALES

The Montgomery Art Guild will charge a 20% commission on the sale of works at this exhibit. If your work is not for sale, mark NFS on your entry form. We must have a price if it is for sale.

Individual artists are responsible for paying sales tax on artwork sold at the show.

SPECIFICATIONS

All work must be dry and suitably framed. Gallery wrapped paintings will be accepted if canvas works are suitable for museum presentation (painted sides on heavy duty stretcher bars only). Only white, off-white or black mats will be accepted. No Gicleé reproductions of original art in another medium will be permitted. (For example, no Gicleé prints of oils, acrylics, watercolors, etc.)

Works must hang by a secured wire. No sawtooth hangers.

Two-dimensional framed works must be no larger than 44 inches exactly in either direction due to flat space limitations (no exceptions). Sculptures may not exceed 6' x 4' x 4' (height x width x depth). Artists must make their own arrangements for works that require special hanging or placement (multi-sectional works, etc.)

A completed entry card must be attached to the back of each work.

Regions Bank reserves the right to final discretion of the works selected for exhibition based upon appropriateness of content.

*Nonaccepted works CANNOT be picked up during the Opening Reception on Sunday. See calendar for pickup dates and times.

INSTRUCTIONS

COMPLETE **BEFORE BRINGING WORK TO BANK**

Complete accurately, all information requested on the entry, registration, and notification cards. Please print to ensure the legibility of your listing for accuracy in the catalog, on exhibition labels, and in publicity.

Attach a completed **entry card** to the **back of each work** making sure the entry title # on the work matches the # on the registration and notification card.

Make out your check, payable to the Montgomery Art Guild, for the appropriate **entry fee**.

Prepare a **self-addressed stamped envelope**. The notification card will be mailed to you in the SASE with the results of the juror's decision.
